

Peer Evaluation Form Intent and Instructions

The Oregon State University Department of Crop and Soil Science Non-classroom Teaching Peer Evaluation Form is intended to be used by CSS faculty who have the opportunity to attend presentations by other CSS faculty or to participate in comprehensive workshops or programs. Faculty may also give the form to other peers (faculty from other OSU departments or other universities or peers from other county, state or federal agencies) for their use in providing feed back to a faculty member. The form is not intended to be used in for clientele assessments.

This primary purpose of this form is to provide constructive comments about teaching and presentation skills. Where appropriate, suggestions for skill improvement are provided. In addition, it can be used to meet the peer evaluation requirements in the PROF and P&T processes.

You have the ability to change or customize the document for each presentation. If you want information not requested, insert questions on the topic. If you do not wish a numerical ranking be made, eliminate this portion of the form.

The Departmental goals and use for the form are:

- To provide feedback to colleagues so they can improve their presentation and program delivery skills - content, delivery, audience interaction, appropriateness of teaching methods, was learning achieved, etc.
- To have peer evaluations in hand for promotion and tenure purposes - these are required as part of the P&T process.
- To meet annual peer evaluation requirement for extension faculty
